### Confirmation

Herewith the following facts concerning our Master Program are confirmed:

The Master Program "Master Architecture (DIA)" of Hochschule Anhalt, Department of Architecture, Facility Management and Geo-Information at Campus Dessau leads to the degree of M.A., It is a full-time program, running over the course of 4 semesters, is taught completely in English and requires compulsory attendance with lectures, seminars, internships, excursions, exercises and projects. The program starts annually with winter semester.

**The duration of the upcoming winter semester is October 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022 and we are preparing for a start in presence.**

Should there be limitations due to the pandemic again, the course still includes attendance components that require presence at the Anhalt University in Dessau-Rosslau.

Hochschule Anhalt is a federal institution, and the named Master Program has been accredited by AQAS in 2007 and ASIIN in 2014. The academic degree „Master of Arts“, awarded by the Hochschule Anhalt, is listed in Annex V of the Professional Qualifications Directive 2005/36/EC and hence fulfils the qualification requirements of article 46 of the European Directive.

Currently the general administrative fee for this program - per semester - is  
850,-€ (for the Master Program) plus  
86,-€ (for semester contribution)

As payment of the semester fee is a prerequisite for enrolment in each semester the personal certification of enrolment ("Immatrikulationsbescheinigung") is also proof of fee payment for each student.
