

Announcing the election nominations

for the election of student representatives to the self-governing bodies on 13 June 2018

The Election Committee has approved the following nominations. In accordance with paragraph 9 of the Ordnung zur Durchführung von Wahlen an der Hochschule Anhalt (Regulations for Conducting Elections at Anhalt University) of 16 March 2005, the following should be noted:

1. The elected members are elected by the eligible voters of the groups of voters in direct, free, equal and secret elections according to the principles of either personalized proportional representation or majority elections. If the number of voters in one group of voters who is eligible to vote for self-governing body representatives is the same as or smaller than the number of representatives to be elected in this group, paragraph 30 of the Ordnung zur Durchführung von Wahlen an der Hochschule Anhalt (Regulations for Conducting Elections at Anhalt University) comes into force.

2. Proportional representation takes place if three or more representatives are to be elected by a group of voters and at least two valid nominations have been submitted by this group of voters and these nominations taken together have at least twice as many applicants as the number of members to be elected. The voter has as many votes as the number of members of his group to be elected (total votes). The voter may distribute the total votes on the candidates of the nominations and cast up to two votes for one candidate. With the total votes in mind, the voter should cast his/her vote by ticking the pre-printed names of candidates on the ballot paper in the columns '1st vote' or '2nd vote'. The seats are distributed according to the d'Hondt method.

3. Majority election with restriction to the proposed candidates only takes place if less than three representatives are to be elected by a group of voters and at least two valid nominations are submitted and these nominations taken together have at least twice as many applicants as the number of members to be elected. The voter has as many votes as the number of members of his group to be elected (total votes). The voter may distribute the total votes on the candidates of the nominations. The voter may cast only one vote for a candidate. With the total votes in mind, the voter should cast his/her vote by ticking the pre-printed names of candidates on the ballot paper. The candidates with the highest numbers of votes are allocated seats in sequential order of these figures.

4. Majority election without restriction to the proposed candidates takes place if only one valid nomination or no valid nomination was submitted by a group of voters or if only nominations with a single candidate were submitted or if the number of candidates in the submitted nominations taken together is not twice as large as the number of members to be elected. The voter has as many votes as the number of members of his group to be elected. The voter may cast one vote only for a candidate or someone else electable. With the total votes in mind, the voter should cast his/her vote by ticking the pre-printed names of candidates on the ballot paper or by entering the names of other electable members of his/her group of voters in a way so as to clearly identify the member(s). The candidates or another electable person with the highest number of votes are allocated seats in sequential order of these figures.

Overview of the approved election nominations

I. Elections to the Senate (Senat)

4 members to be elected. Election system: **majority election without restriction**.
Members can be ticked or entered. Keywords have no meaning for the election.

II. Election of Department Committees (*Fachbereichsräte*)

A maximum of 2 names of electable persons may be ticked on the ballot papers (for majority elections with restriction, Dep.2) or may be entered (for majority election without restriction, Dep.1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7).
