Decision

of the Board of Management (*Präsidium*) of Anhalt University of Applied Sciences
of March 20, 2020

complementary to the derogation of March 16, 2020 for conducting master's thesis, bachelor's thesis and diploma thesis colloquia

(1) Paragraph 2 of the derogation for conducting master's thesis, bachelor's thesis and diploma thesis colloquia applies to all examinations labelled „*PK – Präsentation und Kolloquium*“ (presentation and colloquium) in the respective degree program and examination regulations. This applies in particular to internships (*Berufspraktika*) requiring a colloquium for completion.

(2) The grade of the presentation or the grade of another type of examination set in accordance with the degree program and examination regulations (and in lieu of the colloquium) entered on the examination minutes of the final thesis (application for admission to the final thesis / *Antrag auf Zulassung zur Abschlussarbeit*, page / Seite 2) is to be signed, until revocation, by the first examiner only. The examination minutes are to be sent to the Office of the Registrar (*Prüfungsamt*) immediately after the colloquium.

The examination minutes are valid, until further notice, without the examination committee's (*Prüfungsausschuss*) confirmation of the proper course of the examination.

(3) An **internship** (*Berufspraktikum*) which had to be terminated by the company or due to other justified circumstances may be recognized if the student completed at least 50% of the weeks stipulated in the degree program and examination regulations.
